Transit in Humboldt County is administered through a joint powers authority between Humboldt County and the cities of Arcata, Eureka, Fortuna, Rio Dell and Trinidad. HTA provides riders with affordable fixed route and dial-a-ride transportation options that allow access throughout Humboldt County. Services span from Trinidad, south along Hwy. 101 to Benbow and east on Hwy. 299 from Arcata to Willow Creek, including the Arcata-Eureka Airport and the communities of McKinleyville, Eureka and Fortuna. HTA operates and maintains the Redwood Transit System (RTS), Eureka Transit Service (ETS), Willow Creek Transit Service (WC), Southern Humboldt Transit System (SH), Samoa Transit System and Dial-A-Ride ADA Paratransit services.

### **FREQUENCY**

HTA buses are out in our community 309 days and 60,000 hours per year, covering more than 1.2 million miles and carrying 700,000 passengers. Transit spaces are difficult to miss in the consumer market, making them a highly effective advertising solution.

Both widespread and targeted advertising options are available. Customers can choose a specific route or combination of routes to concentrate their messages in certain areas or advertise on intercity systems with countywide impact.

# **DESIGN**

Customers can design their own advertisements or work with HTA's qualified partners. All advertising space is customizable within the standard dimensions.

# **PRODUCTION**

HTA will coordinate production of signs with printing partners.
Completed designs must be received 14 days prior to start of campaign to ensure timely placement.

# **RATES**

Rates are subject to change and represent monthly advertising space, not including design, printing, or installation. Contracts of 6-11 months will be discounted 10%, contracts over 12 months receive a 15% discount. Prepayments in full will be discounted 5%.

\*Printing and installation to be billed separately. All ads must comply with agency advertising policies.

# INFOTAINMENT SCREENS

# **DETAILS**

Our infotainment screens are installed inside all Redwood Transit System, Eureka Transit Service, Willow Creek Transit Service, and Southern Humboldt Transit System buses. Their resolution is 1080 x 1920 HD, displayed vertically in portrait orientation.

### CONTENT

Screens can show videos, livestreams, QR codes, static images, and more, but do not play sound. Content can be arranged freely across the screen. Time-sensitive promotions can have an automatic start and/or end date.

# **RATES**

Pricing is \$150 per month for 15 seconds, sold in 15 second increments. Ads will be put on rotation and play repeatedly throughout the day across all screens. Contracts of 6-11 months will be discounted 10%, contracts over 12 months receive a 15% discount. Prepayments in full will be discounted 5%
